

## Fully Devoted

(Acts 2:36–47)

God takes full responsibility for the life fully devoted to Him.

### 1. Message received. (Acts 2:36-37)

- a. We can accept the message God has for us, allowing our hearts to be pierced by truth.
- b. It is better to give than receive, but sometimes receiving is exactly what God asks us to do.
- c. God has something for you that Satan does not want you to receive.

### 2. Let it go. (Acts 2:38-41)

- a. Full devotion means leaving behind the things that are holding us back.
- b. Full devotion means putting trust where trust is due. (Prov. 3:5-6)
- c. Going public with our faith requires creativity these days.

### 3. Take the plunge. (Acts 2:42-47)

- a. Devotion requires tenacious persistence. An ongoing, active commitment.
- b. Devotion is deciding to stick together.
- c. What we choose to devote ourselves to matters.

-Devoting your mind to God's word.

-Devoting yourself to one-another (Koinonia).

-Devoting yourself to intimate prayer.

- d. Multiplication of the Gospel is God's work that the devoted get to join in.
