The lost can be found.

1. When God says go...you go. (Acts 8:25-30)

- a. God rarely gives easy assignments.
- b. Obedience means that you join the Lord in His work and trust Him to work out the details.
 - Studying God's word is not optional for God's work.
 - There is a skill to starting spiritual conversations, and it is one worth investing in.

2. Seeking God is a great way to find Him. (Acts 8:31-40)

- a. God pursues us as we pursue Him. (Romans 3)
 - Scripture is a wonderful place to begin searching for God.
 - Asking tough questions is a great way to find both truth and God.
- b. Philip was familiar with God's word and how it applies to life's deepest questions. He knew with certainty the relevance of God's word.
 - The "Spirit of God" used the "Word of God" through a "man of God," to bring salvation to the "people of God."
- c. The gospel demands a response.
