A new perspective on suffering.

(Job 38-42) God knows what was, what is, and what will be.

- **1.** God's viewpoint on our suffering is drastically different from our own.
 - a. God knows His creation intimately. (Job 38:1–40:2).
 - b. God knows how he designed the world to function. (Job 40:6-41:34)
- 2. God is God...Forgetting that fact is dangerous.
 - a. We like to think that we are in control, but life has a way of reminding us that we are not. (Job 40:3-5)
 - b. God is always seeking to restore. (Job 42:10-17)
