1Peter 1:3-9

1. What is lost, can be found. (1Peter 1:3)

- a. Through Christ, our failures can be undone.
(Mark 14:31,71)
- b. Our living hope is found in an empty grave.
(Matt 28:1-10)
- c. Jesus was willing to pay your way.

2. In death, we can find life. (1Peter 1:4-9)

- a. Through the mercy of God, death loses its sting.
- b. Our hope is alive and well.
- c. There is no better time than today to cross the line of obedience.

- What are some “dead” things that people try to find Hope in? How do they compare to the living hope found in Jesus Christ?
- What does it look like to obey Christ in your life today and “cross the line?”
