1. It is possible to know where we are going and that is a wonderful thing.

- a. Not knowing: a lousy way to live.
- b. Knowing: gives the Christian life certainty. (Heb 10:19-25)
- c. You can grow in your capacity to know. (2 Peter 1:10, John 21:24, John 3)

2. For those who have been set free, they are free.

- a. Have you made a confession of faith? (Romans 10:9-10, 1 John 5:1)
- b. Have there been changes in your life?
 - How you treat other people. (1 John 4)
 - How you tolerate sin. (1 John 3:4-9)
 - How you fit in the world. (1 John 3:10)

3. Knowing where we are going changes everything.

- a. We should preach the gospel to ourselves every day.
- b. We should have assurance.
- c. We should live like we have been forgiven and set free.
